Finance and Budget Committee

The Budget and Finance Committee is composed of homeowners and members of the Board, charged with making decisions concerning the financial affairs of the Association. The Budget and Finance Committee recommends an annual budget based on the annual reserve study, recommends financial and other policies, assesses the financial impact of all policies and monitors the Association's investments.

Hospitality Committee

Landscape Committee

The committees' purpose is to work with the landscape contractors to keep our property well landscaped and maintained. The Landscape Committee makes recommendations and works with the landscaping contractor on projects approved by the Board. Maintenance Committee

The Fountains Neighborhood Watch work closely with the Summerfield Civic Association Neighborhood Watch Committee which is comprised of a chairman, 15 area coordinators and 97 block captains. There are a total of 113 people working toward the goal of keeping all Summerfield residents safe and healthy.
